Flying-In - Set your GPS to 8T8 and select "Direct-To, Enter, Enter"; Communicate with San Antonio Approach and avoid the TFRs;and look at the Sectional, there's is an 1,128 foot tower (AGL) a few miles ENE. Bring your own tie-downs. Once you are on the ground, Park at the North end in the grass. For more airport info see www.sgapoa.org.
