You, the flying public, are encouraged to attend and to provide input based on your knowledge and experiences. This is also an opportunity to learn from the airport Air Traffic Control Team, Airport Management, operators on the field, and from your fellow pilots.

Please take the time to participate as an active part in your Aviation Community, and to add your weight to move the risk-pendulum toward **SAFETY**.

FLYING IN - Set your GPS to KHYI, Direct-Enter-Enter - Communicate with San Antonio Approach and San Marcos Tower; After landing tell Ground Control you want to park at the Terminal Building.
