As a CFI, what does the Flight Review mean to you? Are you "easy", or are you "hard"? What is your responsibility? And what makes a good Flight Review, anyway? We'll look at the published guidance and discuss techniques to ensure that our Flight Reviews provide reasonable and adequate assurance of a pilot's competence and safety to operate in accordance with their certificate(s) and their normal operations.
