The vast majority of general aviation incidents and accidents are completely avoidable and caused by egregious lapses in Aeronautical Decision Making (ADM), ineffective Crew Resource Management (CRM), and frequently severely lacking Risk Management skills and techniques. CFIs ONLY, please!!!
