Coming from the North or South on U.S. 75, exit at Eldorado Parkway and go East. Eldorado changes to Industrial Blvd at Hwy 5 to the airport. Facility is located to the right of the McKinney Air Center FBO.

As you look at the front of the building the correct doors are on the left. The entrance that should be used is the one with the flag poles in front of the door.
