

## When The Airplane Talks It Pays to Listen

This presentation will address an overview of a pilot's capability to unearth aircraft issues in ways that may provide valuable clues enhancing the ability to expeditiously and cost effectively resolve technical issues. We will explore legality and efficiency for return to service.

Most Professional Pilots recognize the importance of a flight plan. Likewise in most aircraft a plan is needed to solve technical issues. We will evaluate ways to plan problem resolution including: determining paths of influence, root cause analysis and corrective actions.
