

Arrival and Departure Instructions

Arrival: The airfield will open at 0600, no aircraft will be allowed to land prior to this time. Once you arrive, you will not be permitted to depart until 1400 so please plan accordingly. Please check the NOTAMS the morning of for last minute changes. All aircraft contact Columbus Approach Control within 25 miles of Caledonia VORTAC (115.2). To expedite the flow of traffic, one group will be asked to arrive between 0630-0700 and the other group between 0700-0730. We will notify you via phone/email which group you fall under after your registration has been submitted. **No civilian IFR approaches are available, so both IFR and VFR traffic should plan a VFR approach and landing.**

RAPCON will give instructions and coordinate hand-off to Columbus Tower (126.65).

Pattern and Landing: Primary runway for landing will be runway 13C/31C. Tower will call direction of downwind or base with pattern altitude of 1200' MSL (1000' AGL). Tower may direct use of 13L/31R in high traffic situations. (Runway 13R/31L will be closed)

Taxi and Parking: After clear of the runway, contact Ground Control on 121.9 for taxi instructions. You will be directed to the parking area annotated on the attached aerodrome map. Please reference this map to assist ground controllers. Once you enter the parking area, follow the attendant's instructions. **Please bring your own chocks and tie-downs if desired.** A limited number of tie-down points will be available. Once your aircraft is secure, transportation will be provided to the Services Complex.

Departure: Flight planning facilities for departure will be available at base operations at the completion of the program. **You must have a flight plan on file with Base Operations to depart a military installation.** We have included a blank flight plan in this package. Please fill it out prior to arriving because it will be collected and given to base operation to be filed upon arrival. You may depart as early as 2:00 P.M.; however, we do ask that your departure is no later than 6:00 P.M. Contact Ground Control on 121.9 prior to taxi.

Important

- *YOUR DD FORM 2402 MUST BE ON FILE PRIOR TO ARRIVAL.***
- *NO FUEL OR SERVICES WILL BE AVAILABLE AT COLUMBUS AFB***
- *NO AIRCRAFT WILL BE PERMITTED TO REMAIN OVERNIGHT***

Note

1. If you require fuel or other services for your aircraft, Golden Triangle Regional airport is nearby.
2. In the event of poor weather conditions, the fly-in will still go for those who are able to drive in.
