Since 1977, NASA's ASRS (Aviation Safety and Reporting System) is a voluntary reporting system intended to obtain safety information that can be used to prevent accidents. There have been over 1 million confidential reports processed from a diverse cross-section of pilots and other users of the National Airspace System. ASRS reports can be searched and pilots, etc. can benefit from the information. Learn how to use this important (and FREE) system when it matters most to you, and how to engage in the ASRS to help your fellow pilots.
