Since 1977, NASA's ASRS (Aviation Safety and Reporting System) has provided pilots, flight crew, controllers and maintenance professionals with a voluntary means of contributing to aviation safety. In the last 4 decades, there have been over 1 million confidential reports filed by this diverse group of National Airspace System users. Learn how you can use the ASRS to protect your pilot privileges, share safety concerns particular to you and your flying, and research and learn about problems faced through the years by pilots like you by accessing this valuable - and free - system.
