

## (Note Corrected Start Time) To Fly or Not to Fly?

Is your flight legal, safe & prudent? Learn how to use the P.A.V.E. checklist to facilitate the Go/No-Go decision-making process. Learn to stop the accident before it happens by recognizing the links in the accident chain as they present themselves to you. And while we're at it; let's learn when it is legal to fly and when it's not. We also will discuss various methods of preparing for a flight to make it both safe and legal. Included will be some of the best tools available utilizing smart-phones and/or tablets to obtain all available information regarding the safety of your flight.

**Directions:** Exit Las Posas Road off 101 freeway, go South. At Pleasant Valley Road, turn right. At Airport Way, turn right. At the stop sign which is Durley Avenue, turn left. CIA on the right side (look for a monument sign) at 305 Durley Avenue. Fly-In--Park at Channel Islands ramp.
