CFI Open Forum - Spring 2015

Bruce Breslau, CFII/FAASTeam Representative, will lead a guided discussion on teaching stalls and spins, including entry, recognition and recovery. Loss of Control in Flight (LOC-I) is one of the leading causes of fatal General Aviation aircraft accidents. Many of those fatalities are the result of stalls and spins. The critical role of the flight instructor in correlating stall/spin tasks and exercises with practical, safe flying will be emphasized. Real-life scenarios, hypotheticals and, most importantly, your own instruction experience and techniques will be examined. THIS EVENT IS OPEN TO CFIs/DPEs/those training to become CFIs and ALL pilots/students who want a better understanding of stalls and spins.
