In September, 2022, the Ventura County Department of Airports (DOA) officially launched **Fly Friendly VC**, a program bringing together local pilots, flight schools that conduct training operations in the region, and the community at large to resolve concerns around noise and safety at the two County airports: Camarillo and Oxnard. Yearly workshops have been presented at either Oxnard or Camarillo airports since the inception FFVC.
