While pilots spend countless hours preparing for mechanical failures and adverse weather, medical emergencies often receive far less attention. Yet a medical event involving a pilot, passenger, or crewmember can rapidly become a critical safety issue requiring immediate action.

This seminar examines the human factors, aeromedical considerations, and emergency response principles that every pilot should understand. Attendees will discuss pilot incapacitation, passenger medical events, decision making under stress, communication, resource management, emergency equipment, and the role of CPR and other life-saving measures when professional medical assistance may be minutes or even hours away.
