

Supermarine Spitfire - - 90% Scale Kit - - Design, Performance & Transition Training Considerations

This program reviews the design roots, development, production and flight characteristics of the original Mark V and VIII series Spitfires and compares them to the current 90% scale replica Mark 26b Spitfire. Specific consideration will be given to the flight characteristics of the replica, and a recommended transition flight training program for a potential builder. If you have an interest in "classic" WW II fighters, design, building and flying high performance E-AB aircraft, this program is for you.
