Through scenario-based training, this seminar discusses common misperceptions that can lead to deadly decisions. In Part One-analysis of our situational awareness "ready level" and recent mid-air collision accidents - You'll learn how to be prepared for challenging circumstances. Part Two concentrates on Stall & Spin Accident prevention, and may identify "holes in your training" that when properly addressed will make you much more informed about how to protect yourself from stall / spin situations.
