Our April EAA Chapter 92 program will be of interest to everyone who ever flies over inhospitable terrain where the likelihood of a timely rescue is uncertain.

We will discuss the preparation you need to do before heading into the wild blue (from what to wear and bring to where to keep it). Then, if the unthinkable happens, we will talk about the best way to crash (you have more control than you think). Once the world stops moving it is time to shift into survival mode. When people think survival, they picture setting snares and eating all manner of critters. That is NOT what this is about. We will focus on surviving the first 72 hours and getting found!
