

Compression Testing and Cylinder Inspection with Dave Prizio

For our May EAA Chapter 92 meeting, join us for a tutorial on cylinder inspection. We will look at differential compression testing, including its strengths and weaknesses. We will also look at the use of an inexpensive bore scope to examine the interior of aircraft engine cylinders. By combining information from both of these tests an airplane owner can make a better decision about when to remove and repair or replace a cylinder versus keep flying with it.

Directions: On Sand Canyon Avenue between the 5 and 405. Corner of Sand Canyon and Waterworks Way. Turn LEFT after entering parking lot from Sand Canyon. If entering from Waterworks Way, continue through parking lot to SECOND building. Follow signs to Community Conference Room in 15500 Sand Canyon building.
