

Winslow-Lindbergh Regional Airport Fly-In on July 27, 2013, in Winslow, Arizona

The Winslow-Lindbergh Regional Airport is hosting the *Journeys to Winslow* Fly-In on Saturday, July 27, from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. This special event commemorates Winslow's historic airport, which played a pioneering role in early coast-to-coast passenger service.

The City of Winslow Airport Commission, Winslow Rotary Club, and Wiseman Aviation are hosting this free program during Winslow's tour stop of the Smithsonian's *Journey Stories* traveling exhibition, presented by the Old Trails Museum at La Posada Hotel.

There will be a \$5 pancake breakfast from 9 to 11 a.m., historical displays in the hangar, and classic cars in the airport parking area. Shuttles to La Posada to see *Journey Stories* and the companion local exhibit, *Journeys to Winslow*, will be available.

Pilots who arrive on Friday, July 26, are invited to an evening cookout hosted by Wiseman Aviation on the patio of the restored 1930s terminal.
