Mike Radomsky, a FAASTeam Representative from the Las Vegas area, flew a single-engine Cirrus SR22 solo from Davis, California to Brisbane, Australia in October 2012 to deliver the plane to its new owner.

The months of planning and preparation alone were an adventure! Mike will share highlights of his experience (with lots of great photos and video), including his risk management plan, airplane modifications, the FAA requirements, and the special challenges of managing fuel, navigation, communications, and in-flight physical/mental fitness during this unique trans-Pacific trip.

When your flight's gone about as bad as it possibly could, your survival may well depend upon what you have on your person, not that survival kit you so carefully packed that's burned to a crisp. Doug will give you the straight info on the fundamental survival gear you should never be without and, just as important, what gear is worth betting your life on and what isn't.

Directions: *Entering at Dan Carrell Dr.* Enter the ERAU campus from Willow Creek Rd. at the intersection of Dan Carrell Dr. and Heritage Park Rd. (this is the only entrance with a traffic light). At the round-about, exit at the first opportunity - north on Dobberteen Dr.. The DLC, building 20, is on the left side, about .1 miles from the round-about.

Entering at Haas Blvd. Enter the ERAU campus from Willow Creek Rd., northernmost entrance, on Haas Blvd.. At the first four-way intersection, turn left on Dobberteen Dr.. The DLC, building 20, is on the right side, about .1 miles from the intersection.
