Basic Communications - the communication process, various communication methods and styles, ways pilots can improve their communications and overcome common barriers.

The Impossible Turn - Emphasis on loss of control accidents during takeoff and landing phases, and "The Impossible Turn" - attempting to turn back to the departure airport if a power or performance loss occurs during departure.
