Loss of Control and the Impossible Turn

Loss of aircraft control continues to be a leading concern of the NTSB and the FAA. We will discuss the leading causes of loss of control using accidents, with an emphasis on the takeoff and landing phases. Included in the presentation is a discussion on the "The impossible Turn", the too-often fatal urge for pilots to turn back to their departure airport should they experience a power or performance loss on the departure leg. The presentation will include several audio and video segments of accident sequences. There will be plenty of opportunity to ask questions and participate in the discussion.

Directions: From Show Low, take Deuce of Clubs/U.S. Highway 60 east toward Springerville. Just as you leave town, the airport will be on the left. Turn left onto Airport Rd. Turn right on Airport Loop Rd and park in the airport parking. Watch for an FAASafety Sandwich board to guide you to the event.
