

Maintaining Control of Your Attitude

This seminar will include an overview of the NTSB and Loss of Control statistics, and present the lessons learned from several loss of control accidents, with an emphasis on human factors.

Directions: ***Entering at Haas Blvd.*** Enter the ERAU campus from Willow Creek Rd., northernmost entrance, on Haas Blvd. At the first four-way intersection, continue on Haas Blvd. and proceed to parking in either Lot D or E. The Jack R. Hunt Student Union - Lower Hangar, building 16, is accessible by following the walkway between lots D and E.

Entering at Dan Carrell Dr. Enter the ERAU campus from Willow Creek Rd. at the intersection of Dan Carrell Dr. and Heritage Park Rd. (this is the only entrance with a traffic light). At the round-about, exit at the first opportunity - north on Dobberteen Dr.. Proceed on Dobberteen Dr. until reaching a stop sign, at the intersection with Haas Blvd.. Turn left onto Haas Blvd. and proceed to parking in either Lot D or E. The Jack R. Hunt Student Union - Lower Hangar, building 16, is accessible by following the walkway between lots D and E.
