On July 15, 2016, Congress passed legislation to extend the FAA's funding. This legislation, FAA Extension, Safety, Security Act of 2016 (FESSA) includes relief from holding an FAA medical certificate for certain pilots. This relief is called BasicMed. This event will discuss the requirements of BasicMed to include: When can I fly under BasicMed, What do I need to do to fly under BasicMed, the Aircraft and Operating requirements.
