Ryan Field Airport Runway Safety Action Team (RSAT) Meeting

Stephen Corcoran, Ryan Field Air Traffic Control Tower, Manager J. Fernando Morales III, FAA Runway Safety Program Manager, AWP Runway Safety Group: Runway incursions remain a serious concern nationally. One important component of our ongoing effort to improve surface safety at RYN Airport involves conducting a Runway safety Action Team (RSAT) meeting at least once each year.

The purpose of this RSAT meeting is to unite those individuals and organizations that are actively involved in air traffic operations and movement of aircraft, vehicles and equipment on the Airport Operations Area (AOA). We look for participation from all major airport interests including tenants, fixed base operators, airport operations, maintenance personnel and airport users.

Participants are asked to help develop recommendations and solutions to enhance surface safety. Those recommendations serve as the foundation for a site-specific Runway Safety Action Plan.
