4. Radio Frequency Coordination when entering a Parachute Jump Area

From the North Loop 202 (Red Mountain Freeway) take exit 21 to Higley Road. Proceed south on Higley Road for 1.3 miles to E Falcon Drive. Turn right onto E Falcon Drive for .3 miles.
