From the west valley, take I-10 to the exit for Sky Harbor International Airport (exit 149) and drive to parking in Terminal 3 Parking garage. From the Southeast valley, take I-10 to the Hohokam Expressway, AZ-143 (Exit 153A) to E. Sky Harbor Blvd (Exit 3B) to the terminal 3 Parking garage. From the East and Northeast valley take AZ-202 to E. Sky Harbor Blvd (Exit 5) to the terminal 3 Parking garage. Park in Terminal 3 garage and walk towards Terminal 4. Guard shack is located on the south side of the terminals between terminal 3 and terminal 4. **Parking will not be validated, participants will have to pay for parking. Visitors must be US citizens with valid photo ID. All visitors will go through security screening.**
