Enter the ERAU campus from Willow Creek Rd. at the intersection of Dan Carrell Dr. and Heritage Park Rd.. At the round-about, exit at the first opportunity - north on Dobberteen Dr.. The Robertson Air Safety Center (RASC 1) Building 21 is on the right side across the street from Parking Lot G, approximately .1 miles from the round-about. Entering at Haas Blvd, enter the ERAU campus from Willow Creek Rd., northernmost entrance, on Haas Blvd. At the first four-way intersection, turn left on Dobberteen Dr. The primary parking is in Parking Lot G, is on the right side, about .1 miles from the intersection. Secondary parking options in Lots E&F. If parking in Lot G, walk across Dobberteen Dr to RASC 1 and you can enter Room 102 from the front or rear entrances to the building. Expect 1.5 hours of safety presentations.
