To highlight the importance of maintaining instrument proficiency we'll review ATC tapes and ADS/B track data of a couple very recent fatal spatial disorientation accidents in SOCAL as examples of Loss of Control Inflight accidents. LOC-I accidents are the #1 cause of GA Fatal accidents. We'll also look at some of human factors which can impair our judgment, and the dangers of pushing on with over confidence.
