IFR is high workload! Staying safe requires a pilot to attend to and manage several different tasks simultaneously. While easy for computers, multi-tasking can be difficult for us humans.

In this seminar, presenter Jason Miller provides you with tips and tricks about how to more effectively manage IFR workload. He will identify all the different demands on a pilot's attention within the IFR environment, and share his system for prioritizing and effectively processing the workload. The system helps you build redundancy (a safety net) into your single-pilot instrument flying, as well as help you stay ahead of the airplane.
