Mr. Taber will highlight areas that many pilots have never looked closely at, or haven't reviewed since IFR ground school, and will lead a discussion about commonly misunderstood topics in Instrument Flight Rules. This seminar is open to all, but geared toward current and aspiring instrument pilots.

Mr. Taber is a check airman and training captain with over 20 years and 12,000 hours of air charter experience throughout the western United States and is a regular guest speaker at San Carlos Flight Center seminars.
