The New Pilot's Bill of Rights: How does it affect me?

Learn about the recently passed Pilot's Bill of Rights. Pilot and Aviation Attorney Ronnie Gipson will help you better understand the FAA's enforcement process, how your rights have now been strengthened, and how you can protect your ticket if it is ever subject to a revocation or suspension proceeding. He will also discuss emergency and non-emergency actions by the FAA and how the Pilot's Bill of Rights restores fairness to the system.

Presenter Ronnie Gipson is a member of the AOPA Legal Panel and the EAA Legal Advisory Council. He will provide tips to follow when faced with a possible enforcement action by the FAA.
