CFI Seminar Series - Teaching with Slogans and Memory Aids

We've all heard of a GUMPS checklist, but have you heard of "Expedite and Set the Power Right!" Every instructor has a handful of memory aids to help new pilots remember what is important in key phases of flight. Some memory aids cover comprehensive knowledge items a pilot needs to know (e.g., IMSAFE) and some are meant to stress the order of importance (e.g., Aviate, Navigate, Communicate). What are your slogans and jingles you use in your training? What cool memory aids have you coined that you find effective? Bring your best flight training slogans and share your knowledge with a group of like-minded CFIs.
