

Spectacular Soaring

The Southern Alps of New Zealand present some of the most dramatic landscapes on the planet. They are a spectacular place to fly sailplanes, offering motorless flights stretching hundreds of miles over and among glacier capped peaks. When the wind blows hard, mountain waves set up and soaring flights to 20,000 foot altitudes and beyond are common.

Directions: Hwy 101, exit San Martin Ave, go west one short block, (from 101 south bound, a very short block) to Murphy Ave, south on Murphy, around the west of E16, look for a sign of the Museum. Overflow parking on Murphy Ave.
