# G1000 System Failures

Any pilot who flies a Garmin 1000-equipped airplane knows what a powerful tool it is for navigation, situational awareness, obtaining in-flight information, and monitoring the health of your engine. But with great power, comes great responsibility, and so every pilot of a G1000 aircraft should challenge himself or herself to dive deeper into understanding how the system modules interact and how failures in one system or another present themselves to the pilot. In this seminar we will take a look at potential failure modes and operation/failure mode scenarios and how to recognize each failure. SCFC's G1000 Expert Instructor Brian Eliot will also discuss response plans and ways to maintain flight safety throughout an avionics malfunction or failure. Mr. Eliot has years of experience in emergency and systems failure training using advanced simulators like the PFC multi-screen G1000 simulator at the Flight Center. After the seminar, he will also be available by appointment to practice the various scenarios with pilots looking to complete emergency training.
