Role of Flight Simulators In Modern Pilot Training

Beyond the benefit of skills improvement, the ability of pilots to actually log time in FAA approved simulators can significantly lower the cost of training for certificates and ratings. This presentation will describe the types of simulators now available, their capability, how they work, their strengths and limitations. It will also include an overview of what type of training can be accomplished in simulator and what time can be logged. Flight simulators play an important role in modern pilot training, both for improving proficiency and maintaining skills. Their sophistication and fidelity has consistently improved over time while the cost of low end systems has reduced, so the technology is increasingly accessible and valuable to GA pilots. The speaker, Carl Suttle, has been working with flight simulators since he joined the Royal Air Force in 1978. He has worked on the Phantom F4, Sea King V ASW, Shorts Tucano, Air Navigation Trainers as a maintenance engineer, design engineer, system designer, project and program manager. Since moving to the United States 20 years ago he has worked for simulation technology companies selling the last one to SAIC eight years ago and retiring. Then he bought a Cirrus...
