

Airport Construction at Monterey Airport

The Airport Construction Project Manager walks us through any changes critical to safety of flight including changes to runway lengths; signs, markings and lighting and approaches including airport practices to notify pilots about services affected by planned construction at Monterey Airport.

Directions: From the North: Take Highway 1 South to Monterey. Take the Highway 68 East Exit towards Salinas. Merge onto Monterey-Salinas Highway (Hwy 68 East). Go approximately 1.5 miles and turn LEFT onto Olmsted Road. Olmsted Road goes directly to the Monterey Regional Airport. From the South: Take Highway 1 North to Monterey. Take Highway 68 EAST towards Salinas. Merge onto Monterey-Salinas Highway (Highway 68 East). Follow directions above. http://www.montereyairport.com/mry_directions.html
