# **Fly/Ski/Fly: Perfecting the One-Day Ski Odyssey**

Bay Area snow skiers are all too familiar with the long, slow weekend drive up to Truckee and Lake Tahoe. As pilots, we are above all that. We are the lucky few who can skip the long, boring, frustrating drive and enjoy a quick, spectacular flight instead. And we still can hit the slopes in time for the first lift. Last winter, FlyOutGroup member Dan Zitter perfected the One-Day Sky Odyssey and made many quick ski trips to the Truckee. We've invited him to share what he's learned and to lead a discussion on the logistics of flying to Truckee for a skiing day trip. He will discuss how to take advantage of local transportation, how to anticipate good and bad weather, and considerations for safely flying to the mountains in winter, including route selection and 'Go/No Go Decisions'. Learn the secret to waking up in your own bed, enjoying a day of mountain skiing, and still making it back home to a good night sleep in your own bed. Save the cost of the resort hotels and use it on AvGas instead. We'll end the seminar with planning for upcoming FlyOutGroup (FOG) ski trips to put Dan's method into action. We hope you can join us.
