

Beyond the Annual: Routine Maintenance That Most People Don't Think About

Every year, student pilots pass their Private Pilot checkrides with the help of mnemonic aids like IMSAFE, GOOSE A CAT, and AV1ATE. Often this helps them understand a topic, but only at the surface level. AV1ATE is used to remind a student of required inspections of the aircraft, but it only scratches the surface of why regular maintenance, and inspections are important to keep a plane flying smoothly.
