Predicting Local Weather without a Forecast

As a student and new pilot, a weather briefing is always required. The correlation between weather briefing and checking the weather can be confusing. Dave Kramer is a private pilot fascinated by weather. He has sought to gain a deeper understanding of weather, and his journey has taken him into some interesting areas. This lecture is an attempt to look at the environment with our 5 senses, and to learn better ways to predict the weather in the short term and to correlate what we see with our weather and aviation knowledge. We will try to be aware of our environment with human senses; by looking at the sky and clouds, feeling the temperature, humidity and wind, hearing the rain and the thunder, smelling the land and tasting the salt in the air. The lecture will be used to stimulate discussion from our seasoned pilots and elicit their invaluable experience and stories to help us learn and remember weather and flying concepts and techniques. Presenter Dave Kramer is a private pilot and is currently pursuing an instrument rating. By day he is a physician specializing in ophthalmology.
