

# Automatic Dependent Surveillance-Broadcast (ADS-B) – What It Is and Why You Need It!

Automatic Dependent Surveillance–Broadcast (ADS–B) is a cooperative surveillance technology in which an aircraft determines its own position via satellite navigation and periodically broadcasts it.

**Directions:** Hwy 101, exit San Martin Ave, go west one short block, (from 101 south bound, a very short block) to Murphy Ave, south on Murphy, around the west of E16, look for a sign of the Museum. Overflow parking on Murphy Ave.
