Monterey Tower - Navigating Class C Airspace

Does flying into a Class Charlie airspace intimidate you? Do ATC controllers make you nervous? Do you want to know how to ask for whale watching or flight through Monterey's airspace?

Erik Fleming, an ATC specialist in the Monterey Tower, will discuss the operations at MRY, sharing tips and local procedures that will help your flight in and out of MRY progress smoothly without stress. He will also answer all of our questions about communicating with tower controllers.

A sign-up sheet will be provided for a Monterey tower tour. This tour will be at a later date, US citizens only, and will include a trip to the Monterey control tower to see ATC in action.

Directions: From HWY 68 Exit on Olmsted toward Monterey Regional Airport. Make the first right turn, just before long-term parking. Follow the road until you reach the access gate. Press the "Call" button and an attendant will let you in. Parking will be behind the AeroDynamic Aviation building.
