

Skydiving at San Martin Airport - Safe Pilot Practices

Skydiving operations began at San Martin airport (E16) February of this year. The operation is being conducted by San Jose Skydiving Center (www.sanjos.skydiving.com). Andy Simmons, owner and operator of the new San Jose Skydiving Center, will present detailed information about the jump zone, the flight area, radio calls, and traffic advisories, including the role played by NorCal TRACON. He will also describe their operations, pilots, instructors, airplanes, jumpers and jumping equipment used. There will be plenty of time for questions at the end.

Directions: Seminar will be held in the lobby of the Reid-Hillview Airport Terminal building. From Highway 680, exit onto Capital Expressway. Travel Southeast on Capital Expressway. At Cunningham Ave. turn Right. Reid-Hillview Terminal building is straight ahead then slightly left.
