

Mountain Flying

This presentation will look at mountain flying through the eyes of a glider pilot. Glider pilots use the robust vertical convection common in the mountain skies aloft for hours and cover hundreds of miles. Colin's philosophy is that light airplane pilots can use the same knowledge and skills to be not only safer, but more efficient pilots, especially when flying in mountain country.
