

# NEW DATE Unmanned Aircraft Systems-September 28th Meeting Postponed until October 26th

Join us at the Watsonville Pilot Association to learn about the new Pt. 107 rule effective August 29th on Unmanned Aircraft Systems (UAS) and how they are inherently different from manned aircraft. Introducing UAS into the nation's and local airspace is challenging for the FAA and aviation community. This seminar shows what it takes to get qualified to earn a Remote Pilot Certificate if you are already a pilot, if you are a student pilot and haven't earned your pilot certificate yet, or if you just want to know more about Unmanned Aircraft Systems.
