FAASTeam UAVs - Current Status and Related Issues

This presentation will cover the current status of the integration of unmanned aircraft systems (UAS) in the national airspace system, from operational authorizations including Certificate of Waiver or Authorizations (COAs) and Section 333 exemptions, to the FAA's Pathfinder program and its development of a traffic management system with NASA. It will also highlight the UAS operations in your geographic area, including sightings reported to the FAA and commercial uses, and how pilots can obtain real time information about UAS operations during pre-flight planning and briefing.

Justine Harrison is an aviation attorney, multi-engine instrument rated pilot, aircraft owner, and experimental aircraft builder. From business aviation (such as corporate aircraft and commercial UAS operations) to aviation businesses and aircraft owners/operators, she assists clients with business, contract, and regulatory matters including FAA petitions for exemption, FAA enforcement defense, aviation business transactions, and purchase, sales, leases, and 1031 exchanges of aircraft.
