Your landing is a little longer and faster than you planned, your right wing gets torn off in the trees, and you wake up who-knows-how-much-later with blood in your eyes, an awful pain in your leg and shoulder, and gasoline everywhere. You're terrified, but at least you survived. Or have you? Your adventure may be just beginning.
