Making students aware of potential loss of control scenarios that commonly and sadly result in fatal accidents is a fundamental responsibility of every professional CFI. Too often the vital importance of this awareness training is bypassed because it is not emphasized enough in training curriculums. Yet it remains a number one fatal causal factor in NTSB accident reports. This forum will review valuable instructional strategies CFIs can employ to enlighten all airmen at all levels of training on potential situations that can result in Loss Of Control.
