# **Preflight Inspection: More than a walk-around**

Preflight inspections are an important part of ensuring a flight is safe. Pilots often receive recurrent training about flight maneuvers and emergency procedures; but when was the last time you and your flight instructor trained on preflight inspections? Maybe you haven't had a lesson about preflight inspections since your first solo flight.

This presentation-workshop will provide you with information and preflight techniques your flight instructor may never have taught you or that you've forgotten. Are you sure you know what is involved in determining the true airworthiness of an aircraft?

This hands on presentation will begin with a PowerPoint on the specifics of a "complete" preflight inspection followed by an opportunity to discuss airworthiness concepts in an open forum format. Attendees will break into small groups and actually perform a preflight after the presentation. How many discrepancies will you be able to find?
