Performing Owner-Operator Preventive Maintenance

The cost of owning and operating an airplane is rising every year and owners are always looking for ways to financially stay in general aviation.

14 CFR 43 Appendix A, paragraph c "Preventive Maintenance" allows owners to perform many basic maintenance tasks.

But before you take your tool box out to your airplane, there are some things you need to know in order to keep your airplane airworthy from a physical condition and a regulatory perspective. It is all too easy to make your aircraft unairworthy if you don't know and do all of the necessary tasks. Do you know when and how you should make a maintenance logbook entry? Do you have the required tools, maintenance documents, skill, and experience that is required by regulation? Did you know that if you haven't previously done the maintenance task then you must be trained or supervised while performing "preventive maintenance"?

FAASTeam Representative Paul Gundersen will discuss some things you need to know before you take advantage of this "cost saving" pilot-owner maintenance activity.
