

The Future: NextGen and ADS-B, Inadvertent VFR Flight into IMC

ADS-B: Long-term goal to increase capacity, lower costs, improve safety, and make the ATC system more efficient for users. ADS-B is at the heart of the NextGen system. Will use GPS position information to provide both air traffic controllers and pilots with much more accurate information than current radar-based system.

VFR into IMC: A top killer of GA pilots and is the largest single cause of GA accidents. Analysis points to several reasons why low ceilings and poor visibility pose such a danger.

Directions: Proceed to Boulder City on US Highway 93/95, thence Highway 95 into downtown Boulder City. Turn right on California Avenue. City Hall will be on the left in back of Post Office. Ample parking in front of City Hall.
